SPORTS EVENT TICKET PURCHASE POLICY

UConn Sports Club (UCSV) dues paid individual members or those with paid family membership have the first priority on any sport event trip planned by the club. Your payment reserves your seat to the event.

Once a UCSV member purchases a ticket(s) to a sports event, they own that ticket(s). If you are unable to attend an event, it is your responsibility to sell or transfer your ticket to another UCSV member by contacting the Sports Event Coordinator for that trip, to see if there is a waiting list of paid members. **This is very important in order to maintain the UCSV for the benefit of its current dues paid members.**

If there is no waiting list the trip will be opened, ten (10) days prior to the event, to non-dues paying individuals. A notice will be publicized advising of the availability of tickets for the event.

If you desire to be seated adjacent to another member, please let the Event Coordinator know at the time of purchase of tickets. If for medical reasons, you need special seating arrangements, please advise the Event Coordinator at the time of ticket purchase. If you need medical or ambulatory assistance, it is your responsibility to provide it.

It is expected that attendees will have a cell phone on their person, or a shared cell phone, at all times while attending the event.

Anyone traveling without a spouse/relative/significant other will be required to provide the name and telephone number of an emergency contact.

The Event Coordinator will notify ticket holders by email with advisories, including reminders of dates, times, meeting points and any other relevant information about the event.
